


Johnson College Facilities COVID survey

- The maintenance and custodial departments are doing a great job.




- We were notified in writing, All College meeting and also a department meeting so everyone's concerns and questions were answered. Very thorough.

- The college provide general quick reference info sheets for students on how to clean up after themselves during and after lab sessions using the provided COVID kit supplies in hopes to make labs even more safe and efficient. Also provide information on how to help them become more aware of their own safety and how following protocols are so important to maintain a safe lab environment.
- I don't think there is anything noteworthy. The procedures in place seem to be complete from my perspective.
- Nothing that I can think of.
- People still seem to be entering Richmond Hall without regard to signs on the door in Jef and Andy's office and they aren't waiting for someone to greet them at the front door. Perhaps larger signs or even stand alone signs by the doors to instruct what they can/can't/have to do?
- Seat covers in all restrooms. Additional hand sanitizer stations outside of all restrooms. Hand sanitizers stations and disinfectant wipes next to vending machines. Signs on vending machines saying it's mandatory to sanitize before purchasing. Floor markers for the vending machines to designate 6 feet apart distancing in case a line forms. Disinfectant wipes on all cafe tables so there's an option for an employee or student to wipe down the table if they don't trust that it has already been cleaned.
- Once the semester begins they may need additional part time personnel for certain days and times to support the schedule. If we are pulling them off their regular cleaning schedule then other areas of the job may lack attention.
