Answer each prompt in clear and organized paragraphs. Responses should be in your own words. If you reference an outside source, it must be sited in the prompt.

All four prompts must be completed by answering the bullet points listed under the prompts. Each prompt should be written using either Times New Roman or Calibri font, 12pt font size, and double spaced. The minimal length for each prompt is noted in parenthesis next to it. Your first and last name must appear in the upper left corner of each page submitted.

- 1. Tell us about yourself: (1 page)
 - Why you have decided to pursue a career in the veterinary profession, aside from your love for animals?
 - What you think is the role of a veterinary technician?
 - What you intend to do with an Associate's degree in Veterinary Nursing?
 - Your experience, if any, with animals and animal medicine.
- 2. From time to time euthanasia is practiced in the field of veterinary medicine. (1/2 page)
 - Conveying your thoughts about euthanasia. In your response, include whether or not you think that euthanasia should be practiced and why you have arrived at that conclusion.
- 3. The National Association of Veterinary Technicians in America has formed a coalition known as the Veterinary Nurse Initiative. (1/2 page)
 - Discuss what the mission of the coalition is and your view on the topic.
