COURSE OBJECTIVE

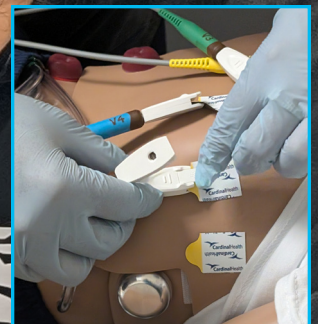
